

# Senate Bill 184

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## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Delays repeal of pesticide use reporting system until January 2, 2016.  
Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to the pesticide use reporting system; amending sections 15, 19 and 22, chapter 1059,  
3 Oregon Laws 1999; and declaring an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 19, chapter 1059, Oregon Laws 1999, is amended to read:

6 **Sec. 19.** The amendments to ORS [*192.502,*] 634.306 and 634.372 by sections [*16,*] 17 and 18, [*of*  
7 *this 1999 Act*] **chapter 1059, Oregon Laws 1999**, become operative on [*December 31, 2009*] **January**  
8 **2, 2016.**

9 **SECTION 2.** Section 22, chapter 1059, Oregon Laws 1999, is amended to read:

10 **Sec. 22.** Sections 2 to 4, 6 to 11, 15 and 21, **chapter 1059, Oregon Laws 1999**, [*of this 1999*  
11 *Act*] are repealed on [*December 31, 2009*] **January 2, 2016.**

12 **SECTION 3.** Section 15, chapter 1059, Oregon Laws 1999, as amended by section 3, chapter 743,  
13 Oregon Laws 2005, and section 2, chapter 162, Oregon Laws 2007, is amended to read:

14 **Sec. 15.** The State Department of Agriculture may use up to \$40 of each pesticide, formula or  
15 formulation registration fee collected under ORS 634.016 during the period beginning January 1,  
16 2008, and ending [*December 31, 2009,*] **January 2, 2016**, to implement the pesticide use reporting  
17 system under sections 2 to 9, chapter 1059, Oregon Laws 1999, as long as the Legislative Assembly  
18 appropriates an equivalent amount of moneys from the General Fund for the system.

19 **SECTION 4.** **This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
20 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect**  
21 **on its passage.**

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**NOTE:** Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted.  
New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
