SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 194

1	On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 29 and delete page 2 and insert:
2	"SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:
3	"(a) 'High priority watershed' means a watershed identified by the Water Resources De-
4	partment and the State Department of Fish and Wildlife as being among those watersheds
5	having the greatest biological need and the greatest restoration opportunity.
6	"(b) 'Measurement' means the use of a water measuring device to determine at the point
7	of diversion:
8	"(A) The amount of surface water diverted; and
9	"(B) The rate or the rate and duty.
10	"(c) 'Significant diversion' means a diversion of surface water:
11	"(A) For which a permit condition requires a water measuring device;
12	"(B) That diverts more than five cubic feet per second; or
13	"(C) That diverts:
14	"(i) More than 0.25 cubic feet per second; and
15	"(ii) More than 10 percent of the lowest monthly 50 percent exceedance flow as defined
16	by the Water Resources Department water availability model.
17	"(d) 'Water measuring device' means equipment installed and maintained by a water user
18	that is capable of measuring at the diversion point the amount of surface water diverted.
19	"(2) The Water Resources Department shall biennially report to the Legislative Assembly
20	regarding:
21	"(a) The number of significant diversions that are located in high priority watersheds,
22	have installed water measuring devices and are measuring water; and
23	"(b) If the measurement of all significant diversions within high priority watersheds has
24	been achieved, the number of significant diversions within this state that have installed wa-
25	ter measuring devices and are measuring water use.
26	"(3) The Water Resources Department shall biennially file with a Senate committee
27	dealing with environmental or natural resource issues a request that the committee hold a
28	public hearing to allow department testimony and public comment regarding the report.".
