

# Senate Bill 223

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## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires county sheriff to provide copy of stalking protective order to special campus security officers at institution of higher education or Oregon Health and Science University if order prohibits contact at institution or university.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to campus safety; creating new provisions; amending ORS 163.741; and declaring an emer-  
3 gency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 163.741 is amended to read:

6 163.741. (1) Whenever a stalking protective order, as authorized by ORS 163.735 or 163.738, is  
7 issued and the person to be restrained has actual notice [*thereof*] **of the order**, the person serving  
8 the order shall deliver [*forthwith*] to the county sheriff a true copy of the order and an affidavit of  
9 proof of service on which it is stated that personal service of the order was made on the respondent.  
10 If an order entered by the court recites that the respondent appeared in person before the court, the  
11 necessity for further service of the order is waived and accompanying proof of service is not nec-  
12 essary.

13 (2) Upon receipt of the order and completion of any required service, the county sheriff shall  
14 [*forthwith*]:

15 (a) Enter the order into the Law Enforcement Data System maintained by the Department of  
16 State Police and into the databases of the National Crime Information Center of the United States  
17 Department of Justice. [*The sheriff shall also*]

18 (b) Provide the complainant with a true copy of the proof of service.

19 (c) **If the order prohibits contact at an institution of higher education listed in ORS**  
20 **352.002 or at Oregon Health and Science University, provide a copy of the order to the special**  
21 **campus security officers authorized by ORS 352.385 or 353.050.**

22 (3) Entry into the Law Enforcement Data System **under subsection (2) of this section** consti-  
23 tutes notice to all law enforcement agencies of the existence of [*such*] **the** order. Law enforcement  
24 agencies shall establish procedures adequate to ensure that an officer at the scene of an alleged  
25 violation of [*such*] **an** order [*may be*] **is** informed of the existence and terms of [*such*] **the** order.  
26 [*Such*] **An** order [*shall be*] **is** fully enforceable in any county in the state.

27 (4) The complainant may elect to deliver documents personally to a county sheriff or to have  
28 them delivered by a private person for entry into the Law Enforcement Data System and the data-  
29 bases of the National Crime Information Center of the United States Department of Justice.
