Provides procedures applicable to motions in arrest of judgment in criminal actions.

2	Relating to criminal procedure; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 136.535.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. ORS 136.535 is amended to read:
5	136.535. (1) Except that a new trial may not be granted on application of the state, ORS 19.430
6	and ORCP 64 A, B and D to G apply to and regulate new trials in criminal actions.
7	(2) The provisions of ORCP 64 F governing motions for a new trial apply to and regulate
8	motions in arrest of judgment in criminal actions.
9	SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 136.535 by section 1 of this 2009 Act apply only to
10	motions in arrest of judgment in criminal actions filed on or after the effective date of this
11	2009 Act.
