

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 299

1 Delete lines 4 through 16 of the printed bill and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** ORS 167.332 is amended to read:

3 “167.332. (1) In addition to any other penalty imposed by law, a person convicted of violating
4 ORS 167.315, 167.325, 167.330, **167.333**, [or] 167.340 **or 167.355** or of a misdemeanor under ORS
5 167.320, may not possess a domestic animal for a period of five years following entry of the con-
6 viction. [*An offense under this subsection is an unclassified misdemeanor punishable by a fine not ex-*
7 *ceeding \$1,000 and forfeiture of the animal as provided in ORS 167.350.*]

8 “(2) In addition to any other penalty imposed by law, a person convicted of violating ORS
9 167.322, **167.365 or 167.428** or of a felony under ORS 167.320, may not possess a domestic animal for
10 a period of 15 years following entry of the conviction. [*An offense under this subsection is an un-*
11 *classified misdemeanor punishable by a fine not exceeding \$5,000 and forfeiture of the animal as pro-*
12 *vided under ORS 167.350.*]

13 “**(3) A person who possesses a domestic animal in violation of this section commits a**
14 **Class C misdemeanor. When a person is convicted of possessing a domestic animal in vio-**
15 **lation of this section, the court may order the removal of domestic animals from the per-**
16 **son’s residence.”.**
