

Senate Bill 318

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Modifies periods for which semi-independent state agencies must report certain information to Governor and Legislative Assembly.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to reports of semi-independent state agencies; creating new provisions; amending ORS
3 182.472 and section 7, chapter 218, Oregon Laws 2007; and declaring an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 182.472 is amended to read:

6 182.472. Not later than [*January 1*] **April 1** of each even-numbered year, each board subject to
7 ORS 182.456 to 182.472 shall submit a report to the Governor, the President of the Senate, the
8 Speaker of the House of Representatives and the Legislative Fiscal Officer. The Legislative Fiscal
9 Officer shall review the reports and shall prepare and submit a statement of findings and conclu-
10 sions to the Joint Legislative Audit Committee **and the Joint Committee on Ways and Means**.
11 The report must include the following:

12 (1) A copy of the most recent audit or financial review of the board.

13 (2) A copy of the actual budget for the prior biennium and a copy of the board's adopted budget
14 for the biennium in which the report is made. The budget documents must show:

15 (a) The beginning balance and ending balance for each of the two biennia;

16 (b) A description of material changes between the two biennia;

17 (c) A description of the public hearing process used to establish the budget adopted for the
18 current biennium; and

19 (d) A description of current fees and proposed changes to fees, along with information support-
20 ing the amounts of the current fees and any proposed changes to the fees.

21 (3) A description of all temporary and permanent rules adopted by the board [*since the last report*
22 *was submitted*] **during the prior biennium**.

23 (4) A description of board actions promoting consumer protection that were taken [*since the last*
24 *report was submitted*] **during the prior biennium**.

25 (5) If the board issues licenses, a description of the board's licensing activities performed [*since*
26 *the last report*] **during the prior biennium** that is adequate to allow evaluation of the board's per-
27 formance of its licensing responsibilities, including:

28 (a) The number of license applications;

29 (b) The number of licenses issued;

30 (c) The number of examinations conducted;

NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.

- 1 (d) The average time between application for and issuance of licenses;
- 2 (e) The number and types of complaints received about persons holding licenses;
- 3 (f) The number and types of investigations conducted;
- 4 (g) The number and types of resolutions of complaints;
- 5 (h) The number and type of sanctions imposed; and
- 6 (i) The number of days between beginning an investigation and reaching a resolution.

7 (6) A description of all other actions taken *[since the last report]* **during the prior biennium** in
8 the performance of the board's statutory responsibilities that is adequate to allow evaluation of the
9 board's performance.

10 **SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 182.472 by section 1 of this 2009 Act apply to re-**
11 **ports, audits and financial reviews required to be submitted on or after the effective date of**
12 **this 2009 Act.**

13 **SECTION 3.** Section 7, chapter 218, Oregon Laws 2007, is amended to read:

14 **Sec. 7.** (1) The amendments to ORS 182.464 and 182.472 by sections 1 and 2 *[of this 2007 Act]*,
15 **chapter 218, Oregon Laws 2007**, apply to financial review schedules for financial reviews to be
16 included in reports to be submitted to the Governor and the Legislative Assembly *[not later than]*
17 **on or after** the date on which the Seventy-fifth Legislative Assembly convenes.

18 (2) The amendments to ORS 297.210 by section 3 *[of this 2007 Act]*, **chapter 218, Oregon Laws**
19 **2007**, apply to audits or reviews required to be made of an institution or department of state gov-
20 ernment when the executive head of the institution or department retires on or after *[the effective*
21 *date of this 2007 Act]* **May 30, 2007.**

22 (3) The amendments to ORS 406.085 by section 4 *[of this 2007 Act]*, **chapter 218, Oregon Laws**
23 **2007**, apply to disbursements made from the Conservatorship Revolving Account on or after *[the ef-*
24 *fective date of this 2007 Act]* **May 30, 2007.**

25 (4) The repeal of ORS 206.320 by section 6 *[of this 2007 Act]*, **chapter 218, Oregon Laws 2007**,
26 applies to services performed by a sheriff on behalf of the state on or after *[the effective date of this*
27 *2007 Act]* **May 30, 2007.**

28 **SECTION 4. This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
29 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect**
30 **on its passage.**

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
