SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Allows persons required to submit written reports to Legislative Assembly to do so through posting electronic form of report on Internet and providing online location in executive summary.] Requires executive summary of written report to Legislative Assembly to include explanation of how to obtain copy of report, including, if report is available on Internet, online location of report. Requires distribution of physical copy of executive summary to each legislator[, offices of presiding officers] and full report to Legislative Administrator.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to electronic submission of reports to the Legislative Assembly; amending ORS 192.245; and

3 declaring an emergency.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 192.245 is amended to read:

6 192.245. (1) Whenever a law of this state requires a written report be submitted to the Legisla-7 tive Assembly, the requirement shall be met by distribution of an executive summary of no more 8 than two pages sent to every member of the Legislative Assembly and one copy of the report to the 9 [office of the Speaker of the House of Representatives, one copy to the office of the President of the 10 Senate and five copies to the Legislative Administration Committee] Legislative Administrator. This 11 requirement does not preclude providing a copy of any report to a specific legislative committee if 12 required by law.

(2) The executive summary described in subsection (1) of this section shall include an
explanation of how a member of the Legislative Assembly may obtain a copy of the report.
If the report is also available on the Internet, the executive summary shall include the online
location of the report.

17 <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 18 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect 19 on its passage.
