

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO B-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 344

1 On page 1 of the printed B-engrossed bill, line 2, delete “and”.

2 In line 3, before the period insert “; and declaring an emergency”.

3 On page 4, line 26, after “after” delete the rest of the line and line 27 and insert “January 1,
4 2010.

5 **“SECTION 9. Notwithstanding ORS 181.665 and 206.015, a person elected to the office of**
6 **sheriff is considered to have met the minimum training standards for basic police officer**
7 **certification if the person:**

8 **“(1) Served at least 25 years as a police officer in this state;**

9 **“(2) Retired from law enforcement under honorable conditions and received or was eligi-**
10 **ble to receive a Department of Public Safety Standards and Training retirement card;**

11 **“(3) Held valid Department of Public Safety Standards and Training certification through**
12 **the executive level at the time of retirement;**

13 **“(4) Previously served as the elected sheriff of a county for not less than four years;**

14 **“(5) Is elected to the office of sheriff in a county the governing body of which certifies**
15 **that the sheriff of the county, as chief executive, primarily provides executive, policymaking,**
16 **managerial and leadership services; and**

17 **“(6) Completes the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training police career**
18 **officer development courses.**

19 **“SECTION 10. Section 9 of this 2009 Act is repealed on January 2, 2010.**

20 **“SECTION 11. This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
21 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect**
22 **on its passage.”.**
