Senate Bill 407

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Requires Superintendent of State Police to allocate at least half of trooper positions created during current biennium to areas outside Interstate 5 corridor.

2	Relating to state police.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) Notwithstanding ORS 181.110, the Superintendent of State Police shall
5	assign at least one-half of the trooper positions created during the biennium beginning July
6	1, 2007, to headquarters and patrol stations that are more than 60 miles from Interstate
7	Highway 5.
8	(2) The troopers assigned under subsection (1) of this section are in addition to, and may
9	not be used to replace, troopers who are currently assigned to headquarters and patrol
10	stations that are more than 60 miles from Interstate Highway 5 and whose positions were
11	created before the biennium beginning July 1, 2007.
