

Senate Bill 407

Sponsored by Senator GIROD

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Superintendent of State Police to allocate at least half of trooper positions created during current biennium to areas outside Interstate 5 corridor.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state police.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) Notwithstanding ORS 181.110, the Superintendent of State Police shall**
5 **assign at least one-half of the trooper positions created during the biennium beginning July**
6 **1, 2007, to headquarters and patrol stations that are more than 60 miles from Interstate**
7 **Highway 5.**

8 **(2) The troopers assigned under subsection (1) of this section are in addition to, and may**
9 **not be used to replace, troopers who are currently assigned to headquarters and patrol**
10 **stations that are more than 60 miles from Interstate Highway 5 and whose positions were**
11 **created before the biennium beginning July 1, 2007.**
