

Senate Bill 408

Sponsored by Senator GIROD

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon State University for men's and women's athletic teams to compete in track and field events.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2009.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to athletics at Oregon State University; appropriating money; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
5 **ated to Oregon State University, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, out of the General**
6 **Fund, the amount of \$_____ for the purpose of:**

7 (1) **Establishing and maintaining a men's athletic team to compete in track and field**
8 **events in the Pacific-10 Conference.**

9 (2) **Maintaining a women's athletic team to compete in track and field events in the**
10 **Pacific-10 Conference.**

11 **SECTION 2. This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
12 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect**
13 **July 1, 2009.**
