## Senate Bill 408

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon State University for men's and women's athletic teams to compete in track and field events.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2009.

2	Relating to athletics at Oregon State University; appropriating money; and declaring an emergency
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-
5	ated to Oregon State University, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, out of the General
6	Fund, the amount of \$ for the purpose of:
7	(1) Establishing and maintaining a men's athletic team to compete in track and field
8	events in the Pacific-10 Conference.
9	(2) Maintaining a women's athletic team to compete in track and field events in the
10	Pacific-10 Conference.
11	SECTION 2. This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
12	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect
13	July 1, 2009.
