

Senate Bill 414

Sponsored by Senator GIROD

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Increases amount of highway funds distributed to counties.
Applies to biennia beginning on or after July 1, 2009.
Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to county funding; creating new provisions; amending ORS 366.739; and declaring an
3 emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 366.739 is amended to read:

6 366.739. Except as otherwise provided in ORS 366.744, the taxes collected under ORS 319.020,
7 319.530, 803.090, 803.420, 818.225, 825.476 and 825.480, minus \$71.2 million per biennium, shall be al-
8 located [24.38] **34.38** percent to counties under ORS 366.762 and 15.57 percent to cities under ORS
9 366.800.

10 **SECTION 2.** The amendments to ORS 366.739 by section 1 of this 2009 Act apply to
11 biennia beginning on or after July 1, 2009.

12 **SECTION 3.** This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
13 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect
14 on its passage.
