

Senate Bill 415

Sponsored by Senator GIROD

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires chief administrative law judge to ensure training in water law for certain administrative law judges. Specifies number of hours of training required every two years.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to water law training for administrative law judges.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The chief administrative law judge of the Office of Administrative**
5 **Hearings shall ensure that all administrative law judges assigned to conduct hearings on**
6 **behalf of the Water Resources Department or the Water Resources Commission have ap-**
7 **propriate training in water law, including but not limited to training in federal and state**
8 **statutory law, case law, rules and policy issues.**

9 **(2) The training specified in subsection (1) of this section shall consist of _____ hours**
10 **every two years.**
