Senate Bill 418

Sponsored by Senator GIROD

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Limits expenditure of lottery moneys used to create jobs or further economic development to use within economically distressed counties.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to expenditure of lottery moneys; and declaring an emergency.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2009 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 461.
 - SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section, "economically distressed county" means a county
- 6 in which, during the two calendar years prior to the approval of an expenditure of moneys
- 7 from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund:
 - (a) The county unemployment rate was in the highest quartile of county unemployment rates in this state; and
 - (b) The county per capita personal income was in the lowest third of county per capita personal incomes in this state.
 - (2) Moneys in the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund that are allocated for the purposes described in ORS 461.540 (1)(a) or (b) may be expended only in economically distressed counties.
 - (3) Subsection (2) of this section does not apply to moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund:
 - (a) For the purpose described in ORS 461.540 (1)(c).
 - (b) To the Education Stability Fund pursuant to ORS 461.540 (2).
- 19 (c) To the Sports Lottery Account pursuant to ORS 461.543 (4).
- 20 (d) To the Problem Gambling Treatment Fund pursuant to ORS 461.549 (2).
- 21 (e) To the Capital Construction Trust Fund pursuant to ORS 461.555 (2).
 - (f) To pay accounting charges incurred pursuant to ORS 291.285.
- 23 (g) To the Regional Light Rail Extension Construction Fund pursuant to ORS 391.130.
- 24 (h) To the Higher Education Capital Construction Fund pursuant to ORS 351.627.
- SECTION 3. This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect on its passage.
