## Senate Bill 424

Sponsored by Senator GIROD; Representative GILLIAM

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Exempts water rights from forfeiture provisions in certain cases. Requires that holder of water right submit affidavit to claim exemption.

- 2 Relating to forfeiture of water rights.
  - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
    - SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2009 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 540.610 to 540.650.
    - SECTION 2. (1) To the extent that water is not used because the holder of a water right engages in crop rotation or tiling, the water right is not subject to the forfeiture provisions of ORS 540.610 to 540.650.
    - (2) The holder of a water right claiming an exemption under this section from the forfeiture provisions of ORS 540.610 to 540.650 must submit an affidavit to the Water Resources Department by December 31 of each calendar year establishing the extent to which water has not been used during that calendar year because the holder of the water right engaged in crop rotation or tiling.
    - (3) If the holder of a water right does not submit the affidavit, the water right is subject to forfeiture and the period of five successive years for failure to use a water right specified in ORS 540.610 is computed from December 31 of the calendar year the holder does not submit the affidavit.
  - SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2009 Act applies to crop rotation or tiling first occurring on or after the effective date of this 2009 Act.
