

Senate Bill 428

Sponsored by Senator METSGER

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Adds State Treasurer and Secretary of State to State Board of Education as nonvoting, ex officio members of board.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1 Relating to members of the State Board of Education; amending ORS 326.021 and 326.031.

2 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

3 **SECTION 1.** ORS 326.021 is amended to read:

4 326.021. (1) The State Board of Education shall consist of:

5 (a) **The State Treasurer, or the designee of the State Treasurer;**

6 (b) **The Secretary of State, or the designee of the Secretary of State; and**

7 (c) Seven members, appointed by the Governor for a term of four years beginning July 1 of the
8 year of appointment, subject to confirmation by the Senate in the manner provided in ORS 171.562
9 and 171.565. [*No person may*] **A person appointed under this paragraph may not** be appointed to
10 serve consecutively more than two full terms as a board member.

11 (2) In making appointments under subsection (1) of this section, the Governor shall select from
12 residents of Oregon one member from each congressional district and [*the remainder*] **two members**
13 from the state at large. [*No member shall be*] **An appointed member may not be** engaged in
14 teaching or participate in the administration or operation of any school.

15 (3) The Governor may remove **appointed** members of the State Board of Education for cause
16 at any time after notice and public hearing.

17 (4) **The State Treasurer and the Secretary of State, or the designee of the State Treas-**
18 **urer or Secretary of State, are nonvoting, ex officio members of the board.**

19 **SECTION 2.** ORS 326.031 is amended to read:

20 326.031. Appointments made to fill vacancies **of the State Board of Education** occurring prior
21 to expiration of a term **of an appointed member** shall be for the remainder of the unexpired term.
22 When a vacancy occurs in an appointment made from a congressional district, the successor shall
23 be appointed from the congressional district for which the vacancy exists.
