"(4) As used in this section: 14 "(a) 'Haze' means: 15 "(A) To subject an individual to whipping, beating, striking, branding or electronic 16 17 shocking, to place a harmful substance on an individual's body or to subject an individual to 18 other similar forms of physical brutality; 19 "(B) To subject an individual to sleep deprivation, exposure to the elements, confinement 20 in a small space or other similar activity that subjects the individual to an unreasonable risk 21of harm or adversely affects the physical health or safety of the individual; "(C) To compel an individual to consume food, liquid, alcohol, controlled substances or 22other substances that subject the individual to an unreasonable risk of harm or adversely 2324 affect the physical health or safety of the individual; or 25"(D) To induce, cause or require an individual to perform a duty or task that involves the 26 commission of a crime or an act of hazing. 27"(b) 'Member' includes volunteers, coaches and faculty advisers of a student organiza-28 tion. 29 "(c) 'Student organization' means a fraternity, sorority, athletic team or other organization that is organized or operating on a college, university or elementary or secondary 30 31 school campus for the purpose of providing members an opportunity to participate in student 32activities of the college, university or elementary or secondary school. 33 "[(1) No fraternity, sorority or other student organization organized or operating on a college or 34 university campus for purposes of participating in student activities of the college or university, nor any 35member of such an organization, shall intentionally haze any member, potential member or person

- 2 the organization or of attaining any office or status therein.]
- 3 "[(2) As used in this section, 'haze' means to subject a person to bodily danger or physical harm
- 4 or a likelihood of bodily danger or physical harm, or to require, encourage, authorize or permit that
- 5 the person be subjected to any of the following:]
- 6 "[(a) Calisthenics;]
- 7 "[(b) Total or substantial nudity on the part of the person;]
- 8 "[(c) Compelled ingestion of any substance by the person;]
- 9 "[(d) Wearing or carrying of any obscene or physically burdensome article by the person;]
- 10 "[(e) Physical assaults upon or offensive physical contact with the person;]
- 11 "[(f) Participation by the person in boxing matches or other physical contests;]
- 12 "[(g) Transportation and abandonment of the person;]
- "[(h) Confinement of the person to unreasonably small, unventilated, insanitary or unlighted
 areas;]
- 15 "[(i) Assignment of pranks to be performed by the person; or]
- 16 "[(j) Compelled personal servitude by the person.]
- 17 "[(3) Subsection (1) of this section does not apply to curricular activities or to athletic teams of or 18 within the college or university]
- 18 within the college or university.]
- "[(4) A fraternity, sorority or other student organization that violates this section commits a Class
 A violation.]
- 21 "[(5) A member of a fraternity, sorority or other student organization, who personally violates this
- 22 section commits a Class B violation.]".
