

Senate Bill 447

Sponsored by Senator METSGER

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires display of original Oregon Constitution in State Capitol.
Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Office of Secretary of State for display.
Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2009.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to public display of the Oregon Constitution; appropriating money; and declaring an emer-
3 gency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall maintain the original Oregon Constitution on**
6 **permanent public display in the State Capitol.**

7 **SECTION 2. There is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary of State, for the**
8 **biennium beginning July 1, 2009, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$_____ for the**
9 **purpose of carrying out the provisions of section 1 of this 2009 Act.**

10 **SECTION 3. This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
11 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect**
12 **July 1, 2009.**
