Senate Bill 462

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON COMMERCE AND WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Extends definition of "base year" to include most recent four calendar quarters preceding benefit year for purpose of determining eligibility for unemployment insurance benefits.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to eligibility for unemployment insurance benefits.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2009 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 657.
 - SECTION 2. (1)(a) Notwithstanding ORS 657.010 (1), in the case of an individual who is not eligible for benefits under ORS 657.150 (2) using the definition in ORS 657.010 (1), "base year" means the last four completed calendar quarters preceding the benefit year.
 - (b) Notwithstanding paragraph (a) of this subsection, a determination of eligibility under ORS 657.150 (2) may not be made using paragraph (a) of this subsection if the individual qualifies or would qualify for regular benefits under the unemployment law of another governmental jurisdiction using that jurisdiction's standard base year.
 - (c) Work and earnings in a calendar quarter that is included in a claim determined to be eligible using the base year as defined in paragraph (a) of this subsection cannot be included in the base year of a subsequent claim unless the subsequent claim's base year is extended under ORS 657.170 to include the calendar quarter.
 - (2)(a) Except as provided in paragraph (b) of this subsection, the definition of "base year" that applies for the purposes of determining an individual's eligibility for benefits under ORS 657.150 applies for all purposes under this chapter related to that individual's claim.
 - (b) When making a finding under ORS 657.170 (1), "base year" has the meaning given that term in ORS 657.010 (1).
 - (3) The Director of the Employment Department shall adopt rules necessary to carry out the provisions of this section.
 - SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2009 Act applies only to claims for benefits filed on or after the operative date of section 2 of this 2009 Act.
 - SECTION 4. Section 2 of this 2009 Act becomes operative on the first day of the week, as defined in ORS 657.010 (15), that begins 90 days after the effective date of a federal law that provides increased funding to states that expand unemployment insurance benefits to individuals who qualify for benefits as described in section 2 (1)(a) of this 2009 Act.
 - <u>SECTION 5.</u> The Director of the Employment Department shall notify the Legislative Counsel upon enactment of the federal law described in section 4 of this 2009 Act.
