Exempts individual under age of 17 from requirement to obtain business license or permit. Provides exceptions.

| 13 | requires a license, certificate, registration, permit or other authorization to conduct a busi- |
| 14 | ness activity that is subject to regulation for the purpose of protecting the environment or |
| 15 | the public health, safety or welfare. |
