

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 47

- 1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “creating new pro-”.
- 2 In line 3, delete “visions;” and delete “342.180 and 342.203” and insert “342.203 and 670.280”.
- 3 On page 2, line 1, after the semicolon insert “or”.
- 4 Delete line 2.
- 5 In line 3, delete “(d)” and insert “(c)” and delete “other”.
- 6 On page 3, line 32, delete “(3)” and insert “(4)”.
- 7 Delete lines 40 through 45.
- 8 On page 4, delete lines 1 through 22 and insert:
- 9 **“SECTION 5.** ORS 670.280 is amended to read:
- 10 “670.280. (1) As used in this section:
- 11 “(a) ‘License’ includes a registration, certification or permit.
- 12 “(b) ‘Licensee’ includes a registrant or a holder of a certification or permit.
- 13 “(2) Except as provided in ORS 342.143 **(3)** or 342.175 **(3)**, a licensing board, commission or
- 14 agency may not deny, suspend or revoke an occupational or professional license solely for the rea-
- 15 son that the applicant or licensee has been convicted of a crime, but it may consider the relationship
- 16 of the facts which support the conviction and all intervening circumstances to the specific occupa-
- 17 tional or professional standards in determining the fitness of the person to receive or hold the li-
- 18 cense.
- 19 “(3) **Except as provided in ORS 342.143 (3) and 342.175 (3)**, a licensing board, commission or
- 20 agency may deny an occupational or professional license or impose discipline on a licensee based
- 21 on conduct that is not undertaken directly in the course of the licensed activity, but that is sub-
- 22 stantially related to the fitness and ability of the applicant or licensee to engage in the activity for
- 23 which the license is required. In determining whether the conduct is substantially related to the
- 24 fitness and ability of the applicant or licensee to engage in the activity for which the license is re-
- 25 quired, the licensing board, commission or agency shall consider the relationship of the facts with
- 26 respect to the conduct and all intervening circumstances to the specific occupational or professional
- 27 standards.”.
- 28 In line 23, delete “7” and insert “6”.
