"(2) Except as provided in ORS 342.143 (3) or 342.175 (3), a licensing board, commission or agency may not deny, suspend or revoke an occupational or professional license solely for the reason that the applicant or licensee has been convicted of a crime, but it may consider the relationship of the facts which support the conviction and all intervening circumstances to the specific occupational or professional standards in determining the fitness of the person to receive or hold the license.

"(3) Except as provided in ORS 342.143 (3) and 342.175 (3), a licensing board, commission or 19 20 agency may deny an occupational or professional license or impose discipline on a licensee based 21on conduct that is not undertaken directly in the course of the licensed activity, but that is sub-22stantially related to the fitness and ability of the applicant or licensee to engage in the activity for which the license is required. In determining whether the conduct is substantially related to the 23 24 fitness and ability of the applicant or licensee to engage in the activity for which the license is re-25quired, the licensing board, commission or agency shall consider the relationship of the facts with respect to the conduct and all intervening circumstances to the specific occupational or professional 2627standards.".
