(1) As used in this section, 'supplemental summer instruction' means in-3 structional hours: "(a) That are provided during the period when school programs typically are not offered; 4 $\mathbf{5}$ "(b) That are provided beyond the minimum number of annual instructional hours required by rule of the State Board of Education; 6 7 "(c) That are not part of the regular school program, as defined in ORS 339.141; and "(d) For which a school district may charge an amount for the instruction. 8 9 "(2)(a) The Department of Education shall establish a pilot program to encourage school 10 districts to provide supplemental summer instruction for the purpose of improving student achievement. 11 12 "(b) The department may encourage school districts to provide supplemental summer 13 instruction by facilitating communication among school districts regarding the implementa-14 tion of supplemental summer instruction by school districts participating in the pilot pro-15gram. 16 "(c) The department may establish a process by which a school district may notify the 17 department that the school district will participate in the pilot program. 18 "(3) A school district that offers supplemental summer instruction may: 19 "(a) Seek public and private funds for the purposes of: 20 "(A) Offering supplemental summer instruction at no charge or for a reduced charge; and 21 "(B) Paying the administrative expenses of the school district related to providing sup-22plemental summer instruction. 23 (b) Accept contributions of funds and assistance from the United States Government 24 and its agencies or from any other source, public or private, for the purposes described in 25paragraph (a) of this subsection. "(c) Enter into contracts with public or private entities to provide supplemental summer 2627instruction in a manner that fulfills the needs of the community. 28"(4) No later than October 1, 2010, the department shall submit a report to the interim 29legislative committees related to education on the pilot program established under this section. 30 31 "SECTION 2.
