

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 484

By COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION AND GENERAL GOVERNMENT

1 Delete lines 4 through 18 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, ‘supplemental summer instruction’ means in-**
3 **structional hours:**

4 **“(a) That are provided during the period when school programs typically are not offered;**

5 **“(b) That are provided beyond the minimum number of annual instructional hours re-**
6 **quired by rule of the State Board of Education;**

7 **“(c) That are not part of the regular school program, as defined in ORS 339.141; and**

8 **“(d) For which a school district may charge an amount for the instruction.**

9 **“(2)(a) The Department of Education shall establish a pilot program to encourage school**
10 **districts to provide supplemental summer instruction for the purpose of improving student**
11 **achievement.**

12 **“(b) The department may encourage school districts to provide supplemental summer**
13 **instruction by facilitating communication among school districts regarding the implementa-**
14 **tion of supplemental summer instruction by school districts participating in the pilot pro-**
15 **gram.**

16 **“(c) The department may establish a process by which a school district may notify the**
17 **department that the school district will participate in the pilot program.**

18 **“(3) A school district that offers supplemental summer instruction may:**

19 **“(a) Seek public and private funds for the purposes of:**

20 **“(A) Offering supplemental summer instruction at no charge or for a reduced charge; and**

21 **“(B) Paying the administrative expenses of the school district related to providing sup-**
22 **plemental summer instruction.**

23 **“(b) Accept contributions of funds and assistance from the United States Government**
24 **and its agencies or from any other source, public or private, for the purposes described in**
25 **paragraph (a) of this subsection.**

26 **“(c) Enter into contracts with public or private entities to provide supplemental summer**
27 **instruction in a manner that fulfills the needs of the community.**

28 **“(4) No later than October 1, 2010, the department shall submit a report to the interim**
29 **legislative committees related to education on the pilot program established under this sec-**
30 **tion.**

31 **“SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2009 Act is repealed January 2, 2012.”.**

32 In line 19, delete “2” and insert “3”.
