## A-Engrossed Senate Bill 51

Ordered by the Senate May 1 Including Senate Amendments dated May 1

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## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Requires Commissioner of Bureau of Labor and Industries by order to set fee adequate to pay costs of education and enforcement related to prevailing wage law and in amount between 0.1 percent and [0.2] 0.125 percent of contract price for public works, except that fee may be no less than \$250 and no more than \$7,500. [Requires commissioner to set forth in rule basis for decision concerning fee.]

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

2	Relating to the Prevailing Wage Education and Enforcement Account; creating new provisions;
3	amending ORS 279C.825; repealing section 8, chapter 844, Oregon Laws 2007; and declaring an
4	emergency.
5	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
6	SECTION 1. ORS 279C.825 is amended to read:
7	279C.825. (1)(a) The Commissioner of the Bureau of Labor and Industries, by [rule] order, shall
8	establish a fee to be paid by the public agency that awards a public works contract subject to ORS
9	279C.800 to 279C.870. The commissioner shall use the fee [shall be used] to pay the costs of:
10	(A) Surveys to determine the prevailing rates of wage;
11	(B) Administering and providing investigations under and enforcement of ORS 279C.800 to
12	279C.870; and
13	(C) Providing educational programs on public contracting law under the Public Contracting
14	Code.
15	(b) The [fee shall be] commissioner shall establish the fee in an amount between 0.1 percent
16	and 0.125 percent of the contract price. However, in no event may a fee be charged and collected
17	that is [more than \$5,000 or] less than [\$100] <b>\$250 or more than \$7,500</b> .
18	(2) The commissioner shall pay moneys received under this section into the State Treasury. The
19	moneys shall be credited to the Prevailing Wage Education and Enforcement Account created by
20	ORS 651.185.
21	(3) The public agency shall pay the fee at the time the public agency enters into the public
22	works contract.
23	SECTION 2. The Commissioner of the Bureau of Labor and Industries shall first issue
24	the order described in ORS 279C.825, as amended by section 1 of this 2009 Act, not later than
25	July 15, 2009. The commissioner thereafter shall issue the order not later than 15 days after

- 1 the beginning of each subsequent biennium.
- 2 <u>SECTION 3.</u> Section 8, chapter 844, Oregon Laws 2007, is repealed.

3 <u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public

4 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect
5 on its passage.

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
