

Senate Bill 538

Sponsored by Senator MORRISETTE

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Education to seek federal funds for purpose of funding pilot projects that implement physical activity and learning programs.

Requires department to report to Seventy-sixth Legislative Assembly.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2009.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to physical education; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Education shall seek federal funds for the purpose**
5 **of funding pilot projects that implement physical activity and learning programs.**

6 **(2) For the purpose of funding pilot projects described in subsection (1) of this section,**
7 **the department may accept contributions of funds and assistance from the United States**
8 **Government and its agencies or from any other source, public or private, and agree to con-**
9 **ditions placed on funds not inconsistent with the purpose of promoting pilot projects de-**
10 **scribed in subsection (1) of this section.**

11 **(3) All funds received by the department under this section shall be paid into the De-**
12 **partment of Education Account established in ORS 326.115 to the credit of the department**
13 **for the purpose of this section.**

14 **SECTION 2. The Department of Education shall report to the Seventy-sixth Legislative**
15 **Assembly in the manner described in ORS 192.245 regarding:**

16 **(1) Funding applied for and received under section 1 of this 2009 Act; and**

17 **(2) Pilot projects funded as provided under section 1 of this 2009 Act.**

18 **SECTION 3. This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
19 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect**
20 **July 1, 2009.**
