SENATE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 545

1	On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 2, after "hatcheries" insert "; and declaring an
2	emergency".
3	Delete lines 4 through 25 and delete page 2 and insert:
4	"SECTION 1. (1) The State Department of Fish and Wildlife shall, utilizing information
5	available on the effective date of this 2009 Act, conduct a study of fish hatcheries and make
6	a report of its findings. The report must:
7	"(a) Summarize the environmental impact of producing trout that carry pathogens.
8	"(b) Summarize the environmental impact of producing trout that carry pathogens in a
9	hatchery that also produces salmon and other species of fish.
10	"(c) Summarize the impact on trout production resulting from the production, in the
11	same hatchery, of salmon that carry pathogens.
12	"(d) Summarize the environmental benefits of producing hatchery trout in a pathogen-
13	free environment.
14	"(e) Evaluate the risks associated with pathogens carried by trout produced by state-
15	owned hatcheries.
16	"(f) Compare the feasibility of producing trout that are free, or almost free, of pathogens
17	at state-owned hatcheries with the feasibility of producing trout that are free, or almost
18	free, of pathogens at Desert Springs Trout Farm.
19	"(g) Compare the capacity of state-owned hatcheries to produce trout with the capacity
20	of Desert Springs Trout Farm to produce trout.
21	"(h) Assess, with an emphasis on reducing pathogens, the potential costs and benefits
22	of incorporating the Desert Springs Trout Farm into this state's trout production program
23	after considering:
24	"(A) Fish health;
25	"(B) Environmental impacts;
26	"(C) Fish production quality, quantity and flexibility;
27	"(D) Fish distribution, holding, redistribution and release; and
28	"(E) Anticipated necessary facility modifications and upgrades.
29	"(2) The department shall submit the report required by subsection (1) of this section to
30	the interim legislative committees on environment and natural resources in the manner
31	provided in ORS 192.245 on or before February 1, 2010.
32	"SECTION 2. This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
33	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect

on its passage.".
