A-Engrossed Senate Bill 546

Sponsored by Senator WALKER

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Directs Department of Transportation to include on driver license examination at least two questions pertaining to practices necessary for safe operation of vehicle around motorcyclists.

Requires person of any age applying for first time for motorcycle endorsement to complete motorcycle rider education course.

Increases motorcycle endorsement fees.

[Allows person to enter into motorcycle improvement agreement if person is cited for operating motorcycle without holding motorcycle endorsement. Allows dismissal of charge upon successful completion of motorcycle rider education course.]

Directs Department of Transportation to phase in motorcycle rider education course program for persons 21 years of age and older.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 807.070 is amended to read:

6 807.070. The Department of Transportation shall administer an examination to establish quali-

7 fication for each class of license and endorsement. The examination for each class of license or
8 endorsement [shall] must include all of the following as described:

9 (1) A test of the applicant's eyesight. This subsection does not apply to an applicant with a 10 limited vision condition as defined in ORS 807.355.

(2) A test of the applicant's knowledge and understanding of the traffic laws of this state, safe
 driving practices and factors that cause accidents. The following all apply to the test under this
 subsection:

(a) The test [shall] may not cover any subject that is not presented in the publications of the
 department intended for the instruction of applicants for licenses and driver permits.

(b) The test for each class of license and endorsement [*shall*] **must** include, but is not limited to, a test of knowledge and understanding of traffic laws that relate specifically to the type of driving privileges granted under the specific class of license or endorsement sought.

(c) The test [*under this subsection shall*] **must** include, but is not limited to, the following sub jects:

21 (A) Rights of pedestrians who are blind.

22 (B) The meaning of official traffic signs and signals.

23 (C) Proper operating procedure in emergency situations.

(D) Vehicle safety equipment and its use. 1 2 (E) Practices necessary for safe operation of a vehicle around pedestrians and bicyclists. (F) Practices necessary for safe operation of a vehicle around motorcyclists. 3 (d) The test must include at least two questions pertaining to the practices necessary for 4 safe operation of a vehicle around motorcyclists. 5 [(d)] (e) The test may include a question regarding fuel efficient driving techniques. 6 [(e)] (f) The department may waive the test under circumstances described in ORS 807.072. 7 (3) A test that is an actual demonstration of the applicant's ability to operate a motor vehicle 8 9 without endangering the safety of persons or property. The following apply to this subsection: (a) The actual demonstration for each class of license shall be performed in a vehicle that may 10 be operated under the class of license sought, but that may not be operated under lower classes of 11 12 license. 13 (b) An actual demonstration for a passenger endorsement shall be performed in a vehicle that is designed to transport 16 or more persons, including the driver. 14 15(c) An actual demonstration for a school bus endorsement shall be performed in a school bus. 16 (d) The department may waive the demonstration under circumstances described in ORS 807.072. (4) Any other examination or test, including demonstrations, that the department determines 17 may be necessary to assist the department in establishing whether the applicant is eligible for a li-18 cense under ORS 807.060 or whether the applicant is fit to operate a motor vehicle safely on the 19 20highways of this state. In any examination or test under this subsection, the department shall only conduct an investigation for facts relating directly to the ability of the applicant to operate a motor 2122vehicle safely or other facts that are specifically required to show the fitness of the applicant for 23license.

SECTION 2. ORS 807.170 is amended to read:

807.170. (1) The Department of Transportation shall provide for the granting of driver license
 endorsements in a manner consistent with this section.

(2) The department shall grant an endorsement to any person who complies with all of the fol-lowing requirements:

(a) The person must hold a valid license other than a restricted Class C license issued under the
 vehicle code.

(b) The person must successfully complete any tests and demonstrations referred to in ORS 807.070 that the department determines necessary to determine whether the applicant is qualified for the type of endorsement sought. The actual demonstration required under ORS 807.070, if any, must be performed in a vehicle that may be operated under the endorsement sought but that may not be operated without the endorsement. Tests shall include, but are not limited to, those tests necessary to determine whether the applicant:

(A) Has satisfactory knowledge of laws relating to operation under the type of endorsement
 sought, defensive driving skills, the common causes of accidents involving vehicles operated under
 the type of endorsement sought; and

40 (B) Can operate under the endorsement in a manner that will not jeopardize the safety of per-41 sons or property.

42 (c) The appropriate fee under ORS 807.370 for the endorsement, including the fee for the Mo 43 torcycle Safety Subaccount, must be paid.

(d) If the person is [*under 21 years of age and an applicant*] applying for a motorcycle endorse ment, the person must comply with ORS 807.175.

1 (3) An endorsement granted under this section is subject to the following:

2 (a) It is part of the license upon which it is endorsed and is subject to any provisions applicable 3 to the endorsed license under the statutes of this state.

4 (b) It is valid only if the license endorsed is valid.

5 (c) The appropriate fee under ORS 807.370 must be paid upon renewal of the endorsement in 6 addition to any fee for renewal of the license endorsed.

7 (d) Except as provided under ORS 807.350 or as specifically provided under ORS 809.419, an 8 endorsement cannot be canceled, suspended or revoked separately from the license endorsed. When 9 an endorsed license is canceled, suspended or revoked, all endorsements on the license are subject 10 to the same cancellation, suspension or revocation as the license.

(4) Before the department may renew any license with a motorcycle endorsement, the applicant
shall pay the department the Motorcycle Safety Subaccount fee established under ORS 807.370 in
addition to any fee for renewal of the license.

14 **SECTION 3.** ORS 807.175 is amended to read:

15 807.175. (1) The Department of Transportation may not issue a motorcycle endorsement to 16 [any] **a** person [who is under 21 years of age] unless the person shows to the satisfaction of the de-17 partment that the person has successfully completed a motorcycle rider education course established 18 by the department under ORS 802.320. This requirement is in addition to any other requirement for 19 the endorsement.

(2) Subsection (1) of this section does not apply to a person applying for issuance of a
 motorcycle endorsement under ORS 807.170 who currently holds a motorcycle endorsement
 issued by another state.
