SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Approves certain new or increased fees adopted by State Department of Agriculture.
Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2009.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to financial administration of the State Department of Agriculture; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), the following new or increased fees, adopted by the State Department of Agriculture and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, are approved:

(1) The license fee for nursery growers, other than greenhouse growers of herbaceous plants, and for collectors of native plants shall be as follows:

 39 creased fee of \$1 per head for brand inspection, adopted by the State Department of Agri-
 40 culture and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, is approved.

29 **SECTION 4.** This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
30 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect
31 July 1, 2009.
