

Senate Bill 5511

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Budget and Management Division, Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development for certain biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by department.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds.

Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from timber tax funds.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2009.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to financial administration of the Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development; appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for the following purposes:

(1) **Operations..... \$ 8,439,970**

(2) **Community College Support Fund**

for distribution to community

college districts and community

college service districts \$485,000,000

(3) **Targeted education and**

workforce programs..... \$ 3,430,400

(4) **Debt service on the outstanding**

general obligation bonds sold

pursuant to Article XI-G

of the Oregon Constitution..... \$ 9,961,275

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds, federal funds and those funds described in section 5 of this 2009 Act, collected or received by the Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development, for the following purposes:

(1) **Department of Community**

Colleges and Workforce

Development \$ 3,117,956
