Senate Bill 5521

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Environmental Quality for certain biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, specified bond proceeds and specified federal funds, collected or received by department.

Limits biennial expenditures from lottery moneys allocated from Parks and Natural Resources Fund to department.

Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.

Limits certain biennial expenditures by department from federal funds. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2009.

A BILL FOR AN ACT Relating to financial administration of the Department of Environmental Quality; appropriating

3 money; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> There are appropriated to the Department of Environmental Quality, for the

biennium beginning July 1, 2009, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for the fol lowing purposes:

8 (1) Air quality..... \$ 9,520,182

9 (2) Water quality..... \$ 20,369,146

10 (3) Land quality...... \$ 2,223,333

- 11 (4) Cross program \$ 849,840
- 12 (5) Debt service \$ 5,549,353

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts 13 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limits for payment 14 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, the 1516 proceeds of bonds for the Orphan Site Account and federal funds from congestion mitigation 17and air quality grants, for drinking water protection, beach bacteria monitoring, laboratory accreditation and the Tillamook Estuary Partnership and for smoke monitoring laboratory 18 services, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in this section, collected 19 or received by the Department of Environmental Quality, for the following purposes: 20

Air quality...... \$ 41,098,128 21(1) Water quality...... \$ 22,201,869 22 (2) 23(3) Land quality...... \$ 58,115,803 Cross program \$ 24 (4) 168.375 (5) Agency management...... \$ 23,815,030 25

NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.

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<u>SECTION 3.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$6,056,344 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Parks and Natural Resources Fund to the Department of Environmental Quality for activities and projects to implement section 4 (10), Article XV of the Oregon Constitution.

6 <u>SECTION 4.</u> For the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, expenditures by the Department 7 of Environmental Quality for debt service, for loans made from the Pollution Control Fund 8 and for loans made from the Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund are not limited.

9 <u>SECTION 5.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from federal funds other than those described in section 2 of this 2009 Act collected or received by the Department of Environmental Quality, for the following purposes:

14 (2) Water quality..... \$ 11,564,134

15 (3) Land quality..... \$ 11,678,172

16 (4) Cross program \$ 1,030,249

17 <u>SECTION 6.</u> This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 18 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect 19 July 1, 2009.

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
