SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Office of Private Health Partnerships for biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by office.

Limits biennial expenditures from moneys collected or received by office from Department of Human Services.

Limits biennial expenditures from moneys collected or received by office as reimbursement by department from Health System Fund for office's costs of administering private health option for expanded access to private health insurance for Oregon's children. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2009.

Relating to financial administration of the Office of Private Health Partnerships; appropriating 2

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 4

 $\mathbf{5}$ SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Office of Private Health Partnerships for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$21,481,705. 6

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$647,003 7

is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for payment of 8

9 expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-

cluding lottery funds and federal funds collected or received by the Office of Private Health 10 11 Partnerships.

SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 12 \$99,954,616 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for 13 payment of expenses from moneys, excluding moneys described in section 4 of this 2009 Act, 14 collected or received by the Office of Private Health Partnerships from the Department of 15 **Human Services.** 16

SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 17 \$22,600,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for 18 payment of expenses from moneys collected or received by the Office of Private Health 19 20 Partnerships from the Department of Human Services in accordance with section 1, chapter , Oregon Laws 2009 (Enrolled House Bill 2116). 21
