SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Secretary of State for certain biennial expenses. Limits certain biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by Secretary of State.

Limits certain biennial expenditures by Secretary of State from federal funds. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2009.

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<u>SECTION 3.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
\$7,520,712 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for
payment of expenses for the Help America Vote Act from federal funds collected or received
by the Secretary of State.
<u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect

7 July 1, 2009.

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
