CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to financial administration of the Tobacco Settlement Funds Account; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. In addition to transfers to the Tobacco Enforcement Fund under ORS 293.537, the Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall make the following transfers from the Tobacco Settlement Funds Account for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009:

- (1) **To the Oregon Appropriation
Bond Fund established under
section 3, chapter 11,
Oregon Laws 2003 \$139,146,271**
- (2) **To the Oregon Health
and Science University
Bond Fund..... \$ 31,978,974**
- (3) **To the Department of Human Services
For expenses of the Oregon
Health Plan \$ 30,000,000**

SECTION 2. This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect July 1, 2009.
