SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Limits certain biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by State Treasurer for administrative expenses of State Treasury operations and Oregon 529 College Savings Network.

Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2009.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 2 Relating to financial administration of the State Treasurer; limiting expenditures; and declaring an 3 emergency. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts 5 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limits for payment 6 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the State Treasurer, for the 8 following purposes: 9 10 **(1)** Administrative expenses of State Treasury operations \$ 28,047,822 11 Performance-based compensation 12 bonuses for agency personnel... \$ 604,826 13 Administrative expenses of 14 the Oregon 529 College Savings 15 Network \$ 3,432,561 16 SECTION 2. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, expenditures made by the State 17 Treasurer to pay for cash management services are not limited. 18
