37 Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Oregon Department of Admin-
38 istrative Services for distribution to counties for economic development activities established
39 by section 24, chapter 745, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, is re-
40 duced by \$6,399,691.

41 “**SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative
42 Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Sports Lottery Account estab-
43 lished by section 23, chapter 745, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007,
44 is increased by \$10,017.

45 “**SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative

1 Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Problem Gambling Treatment
2 Fund established by section 11, chapter 745, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning
3 July 1, 2007, is decreased by \$1,189,984.

4 “SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative
5 Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Department of Higher Education
6 established by section 21, chapter 745, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning July 1,
7 2007, is decreased by \$532,268.

35 biennium beginning July 1, 2007, is decreased by \$225,742.

36 “SECTION 13. Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative
37 Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Oregon Department of Admin-
38 istrative Services established by section 19a, chapter 745, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium
39 beginning July 1, 2007, is decreased by \$62,589.

40 “SECTION 14. Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative
41 Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Department of Education es-
42 tablished by section 8, chapter 745, Oregon Laws 2007, and section 41 (2), chapter 16, Oregon
43 Laws 2008, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, is increased by \$13,269,979.

44 “SECTION 15. Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative
45 Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the office of the Governor estab-

1 lished by section 22, chapter 745, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007,
2 is decreased by \$112,000.

3 **“SECTION 16.** Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative
4 Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Economic and Community De-
5 velopment Department for department operations established by section 3 (1), chapter 745,
6 Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, is decreased by \$465,000.

7 **“SECTION 17.** Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative
8 Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Economic and Community De-
9 velopment Department for the Oregon Community Development Fund established by section
10 3 (3), chapter 745, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, is decreased
11 by \$2,883,808.

12 **“SECTION 18.** Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative
13 Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Economic and Community De-
14 velopment Department for the Strategic Reserve for Workforce established by section 3 (4),
15 chapter 745, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, is decreased by
16 \$341,244.

17 **“SECTION 19.** Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative
18 Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Economic and Community De-
19 velopment Department for targeted service providers established by section 3 (5), chapter
20 745, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, is decreased by \$100,000.

21 **“SECTION 20.** Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative
22 Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Economic and Community De-
23 velopment Department for the Oregon Film and Video Office established by section 3 (9),
24 chapter 745, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, is decreased by
25 \$64,085.

26 **“SECTION 21.** Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Watershed
27 Improvement Operating Fund, the allocation from the Oregon Watershed Enhancement
28 Board to the Department of Environmental Quality for activities and projects to implement
29 section 4 (10), Article XV of the Oregon Constitution, established by section 4, chapter 732,
30 Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, is increased by \$427,630.

31 **“SECTION 22.** There is appropriated to the School Day Restoration Fund, for the
32 biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$51,000,000 for the
33 purpose of carrying out the provisions of sections 19 to 21, chapter _____, Oregon Laws
34 2009 (Enrolled Senate Bill 581).

35 **“SECTION 23.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
36 \$16,750 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for
37 payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the office of the Governor.

38 **“SECTION 24.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
39 \$55,639,902 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for
40 payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Department of Higher
41 Education.

42 **“SECTION 25.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
43 \$115,360,098 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for
44 payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Department of Educa-
45 tion for the State School Fund.

1 “**SECTION 26.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropri-
2 ation made to the Water Resources Department by section 47 (2), chapter 16, Oregon Laws
3 2008, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, is decreased by \$694,165.

4 “**SECTION 27.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropri-
5 ation made to the Department of Veterans’ Affairs by section 48 (1), chapter 16, Oregon Laws
6 2008, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, is decreased by \$185,941.

7 “**SECTION 28.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
8 expenditures established by section 1, chapter 19, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium be-
9 ginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or
10 other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, and reimbursements from federal services
11 agreements, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in this section, col-
12 lected or received by the Oregon State Board of Nursing, is increased by \$110,000.

13 “**SECTION 29.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
14 expenditures established by section 1, chapter 37, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium be-
15 ginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or
16 other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, and reimbursements from federal services
17 agreements, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in this section, col-
18 lected or received by the Oregon Board of Dentistry, is increased by \$50,000.

19 “**SECTION 30.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
20 expenditures established by section 1, chapter 38, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium be-
21 ginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or
22 other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, and reimbursements from federal services
23 agreements, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in this section, col-
24 lected or received by the State Board of Psychologist Examiners, is increased by \$98,000.

25 “**SECTION 31.** Section 37, chapter 16, Oregon Laws 2008, is repealed.

26 “**SECTION 32.** This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
27 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect
28 on its passage.”
