

Senate Bill 557

Sponsored by Senator KRUSE (at the request of Jeanette Laboy)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Increases number of video lottery game terminals that can be placed on premises of race meet licensee used for off-race course mutuel wagering.
Conforms language to legislative form and style.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to placement of video lottery game terminals; amending ORS 461.217.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 461.217 is amended to read:

5 461.217. (1) As used in this section, "video lottery game retailer" means a [*contractor*] **person**
6 under contract with the Oregon State Lottery to place video lottery game terminals on premises
7 authorized by the contract.

8 (2) A video lottery game terminal that offers a video lottery game authorized by the Director
9 of the Oregon State Lottery:

10 (a) May be placed for operation only on the premises of [*an establishment*] **a person** that has
11 a contract with the Oregon State Lottery as a video lottery game retailer.

12 (b) [*The terminal*] Must be within the control of an employee of the video lottery game retailer.

13 (c) [*A terminal*] May not be placed in any other business or location.

14 (3) A video lottery game terminal may be placed only on the premises of an establishment li-
15 censed by the Oregon Liquor Control Commission with a full on-premises sales license, a limited
16 on-premises sales license or a brewery-public house license. A video lottery game terminal may be
17 placed only in that part of the premises that is posted by the Oregon Liquor Control Commission
18 as being closed to minors. [*In addition to the requirements of this subsection, the director may by rule*
19 *establish such other criteria and conditions as the director determines appropriate for the placement*
20 *of video lottery game terminals in establishments.*]

21 [(4) *No more than six video lottery terminals may be placed in or on premises described in sub-*
22 *section (3) of this section.*]

23 [(5) *No more than 10 video lottery game terminals may be placed on the premises of a race meet*
24 *licensee licensed under ORS 462.020 that qualifies as a video lottery game retailer.*]

25 (4) **Except as provided in subsection (5) of this section, a video lottery game retailer may**
26 **place up to six video lottery game terminals on premises of the retailer that are described**
27 **in subsection (3) of this section.**

28 (5) **A video lottery game retailer who is a race meet licensee under ORS 462.020 may place**
29 **up to 10 video lottery game terminals on:**

30 (a) **The race course, as defined in ORS 462.010.**

31 (b) **Premises of the race meet licensee used for off-race course mutuel wagering, as au-**

2 **(6) In addition to the requirements of subsection (3) of this section, the director may by**
3 **rule establish other criteria and conditions as the director determines appropriate for the**
4 **placement of video lottery game terminals in establishments as described in subsection (3)**
5 **of this section.**

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
