

Senate Bill 560

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY (at the request of Lane County, Clatsop County)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows dissolution of county service districts without election if district is no longer necessary for its purpose.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1 Relating to dissolution of county service districts; amending ORS 198.940.

2 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

3 **SECTION 1.** ORS 198.940 is amended to read:

4 198.940. The election required by ORS 198.935 shall be dispensed with and the county board
5 shall declare the district dissolved and proceed in accordance with ORS 198.945, if the county board
6 finds that[:]

7 [(1)] dissolution is in the interest of the people of the county[;] and:

8 [(2)] (1) The territory within the affected district is uninhabited;

9 [(3)] (2) The district has failed regularly to elect district board members in accordance with the
10 principal Act of the district; [or]

11 [(4)] (3) For a county service district, dissolution is required due to an absence of public need
12 for continuation of the district, as provided in ORS 451.620; **or**

13 (4) **For a county service district, the district is no longer necessary for the purpose for**
14 **which it was formed.**
