SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits power transmission lines with capacity of 400,000 volts or greater on land zoned for exclusive farm use.

1 A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to transmission lines on land zoned for exclusive farm use; amending ORS 215.438.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 215.438 is amended to read:

5 215.438. (1) A power transmission line with a capacity of 400,000 volts or greater is not

6 an allowable use on land zoned for exclusive farm use.

7 (2) The governing body of a county or its designate may allow a transmission tower over 200

8 feet in height to be established in any zone subject to reasonable conditions imposed by the gov-9 erning body or its designate.
