

Senate Bill 660

Sponsored by Senator ATKINSON

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Authorizes state employee to voluntarily request payroll deduction from employee salary or wages for purposes of making donation to Oregon State Capitol Foundation. Continuously appropriates moneys to foundation.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the Oregon State Capitol Foundation; creating new provisions; amending ORS 276.003;
3 and appropriating money.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. Any state official authorized to disburse funds in payment of salaries or**
6 **wages of state officers or employees is authorized, upon written request of the officer or**
7 **employee, to deduct each month from the salary or wages of the officer or employee the**
8 **amount of moneys designated by the officer or employee for payment to the Oregon State**
9 **Capitol Foundation Fund created under ORS 276.003 or to an organization created by the**
10 **Oregon State Capitol Foundation under ORS 173.500 (3)(d). Moneys deducted from salaries**
11 **or wages under this section shall be paid over promptly and as directed by the Oregon State**
12 **Capitol Foundation, to either the Oregon State Capitol Foundation Fund or to the organiza-**
13 **tion created by the foundation under ORS 173.500 (3)(d), to be used solely for the purposes**
14 **set forth in ORS 173.500 (2)(e). Subject to any rules adopted by the Oregon Department of**
15 **Administrative Services, the state official authorized to disburse funds in payment of salaries**
16 **or wages may prescribe any procedure necessary to carry out this section.**

17 **SECTION 2.** ORS 276.003 is amended to read:

18 276.003. (1) There is created in the General Fund of the State Treasury a State Capitol Operat-
19 ing Account. Moneys credited to the account are appropriated continuously to the Legislative Ad-
20 ministration Committee to pay the expenses of operating, maintaining, protecting and insuring the
21 State Capitol and to reimburse the State Parks and Recreation Department for a share of the ex-
22 penses of ground maintenance, utilities and other necessary expenses.

23 (2) There is established the Oregon State Capitol Foundation Fund in the State Capitol Operat-
24 ing Account of the General Fund established under subsection (1) of this section. All moneys re-
25 ceived by the Legislative Administration Committee allocated to the Oregon State Capitol
26 Foundation shall be credited to the Oregon State Capitol Foundation Fund. **All moneys received**
27 **under section 1 of this 2009 Act and directed to the Oregon State Capitol Foundation Fund**
28 **shall be credited to the Oregon State Capitol Foundation Fund.** All moneys credited to the
29 Oregon State Capitol Foundation Fund are continuously appropriated to the foundation for the
30 purposes of ORS 173.500, **except that moneys received under section 1 of this 2009 Act and**
31 **credited to the Oregon State Capitol Foundation Fund are continuously appropriated for the**

1 **purposes of ORS 173.500 (2)(e).**

2 (3) The Legislative Administration Committee may on behalf of the State of Oregon solicit and
3 accept gifts, grants and donations from public and private sources for the purposes set out in ORS
4 276.002. Such gifts, grants and donations shall be deposited by the committee in separate, appropri-
5 ate trust accounts until such time as required to meet the obligations for which the gifts, grants or
6 donations were intended. When so required, the committee shall deposit the amounts in the Oregon
7 State Capitol Foundation Fund, subject to any limitations imposed by the donors.

8 (4) A gift or donation to the Legislative Administration Committee or to the Oregon State Cap-
9 itol Foundation is a gift or donation to the State of Oregon.

10 **SECTION 3. Section 1 of this 2009 Act applies to payments of salary and wages occurring**
11 **in pay periods beginning on or after January 1, 2010.**
