3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. ORS 30.938 is amended to read:
5	30.938. In any action or claim for relief alleging nuisance or trespass and arising from a practice
6	that is alleged by either party to be a farming or forest practice, the [prevailing party] defendant
7	shall be entitled to judgment for reasonable attorney fees and costs incurred at trial and on appeal.
