Senate Bill 712

Sponsored by Senator BOQUIST; Senators FERRIOLI, GEORGE, KRUSE, STARR, TELFER

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Suspends cost-of-living increases, salary step increases, upward reclassifications, filling of vacant positions, creating new positions and out-of-state travel for state government employees in current biennium. Suspends purchases of additional goods or supplies.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) As used in this section, "state government" has the meaning given that term in ORS 174.111.
 - (2) For the biennium ending June 30, 2009:
 - (a) All cost-of-living increases to salaries of state government employees are suspended;
 - (b) All step increases within the salary range of each state government employee are suspended;
 - (c) All upward reclassifications of state government employees are suspended;
 - (d) Vacant positions within state government may not be filled except when necessary to protect essential services of state government;
 - (e) New positions within state government may not be created except when necessary to protect essential services of state government;
 - (f) If allowed by terms of the agreement or contract and notwithstanding any other law, the terms of any collective bargaining agreement or services contract entered into by state government concerning cost-of-living increases, salary step increases, reclassifications and the filling of vacant positions are suspended;
 - (g) Payments by state government for out-of-state travel by employees of state government are prohibited; and
 - (h) Purchases of goods and supplies for which payment is not already obligated are suspended.
 - (3) When a salary increase suspended under this section is no longer suspended, the salary increase applies only prospectively. State government may not retroactively pay a salary increase suspended under this section for any period during which the salary increase was suspended.
 - (4) This section does not apply to state officers elected by popular vote, or appointed to fill vacancies in elective offices, whose salaries are fixed by law.
 - SECTION 2. This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect
