## Senate Bill 720

Sponsored by Senator TELFER; Senators BOQUIST, FERRIOLI, GEORGE, KRUSE, MORSE, STARR, WHITSETT, WINTERS, Representative WHISNANT

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Provides that court order or judgment relating to custody, parenting time or visitation rights include provision that neither parent may move to residence more than 200 miles further distant from other parent without providing reasonable notice to other parent and court.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to domestic relations; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 107.159.
  - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
  - **SECTION 1.** ORS 107.159 is amended to read:
    - 107.159. (1) **Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section,** in any court order or judgment granting custody of a minor child and parenting time or visitation rights relating to the child, except for an order under ORS 107.700 to 107.735, the court shall include in its order a provision [requiring] that neither parent may move to a residence more than [60] **200** miles further distant from the other parent without giving the other parent reasonable notice of the change of residence and providing a copy of such notice to the court.
    - (2) [Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section,] A parent is not required to give notice of a change of residence if the court, upon ex parte or other motion of the parent and for good cause, enters an order suspending the requirement.
    - SECTION 2. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, the amendments to ORS 107.159 by section 1 of this 2009 Act apply only to court orders or judgments entered on or after the effective date of this 2009 Act.
    - (2) Upon the motion of either party, a court shall modify an order or judgment entered before the effective date of this 2009 Act to conform the order or judgment to ORS 107.159 as amended by section 1 of this 2009 Act.
