SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 741

1	On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, before the period insert "; and declaring an emergency".
2	Delete lines 4 through 31 and delete page 2 and insert:
3	"SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, 'Metolius River Basin' means the portions of the
4	basin identified as Area 1 and Area 2 in the management plan recommended by the Land
5	Conservation and Development Commission.
6	"(2) Pursuant to ORS 197.405 (4), the Legislative Assembly hereby approves the recom
7	mendation of the commission, submitted to the Legislative Assembly on April 2, 2009, tha
8	the Metolius River Basin be designated an area of critical state concern.
9	"(3) The Legislative Assembly approves the management plan included in the commis
10	sion's recommendation pursuant to ORS 197.405 (1)(c) and directs the commission to adop
11	the management plan, by rule, without change except that the commission shall:
12	"(a) Amend section 1.2.4 of the management plan by deleting the following text: 'If the
13	2009 Legislative Assembly enacts a bill that provides for an owner, or affiliate of an owner
14	of the property described in this section to carry out a pilot project to develop a sustainable
15	eco-community outside of Area 1 and Area 2, then the development authorized by this sec
16	tion is limited to two forest dwellings.'
17	"(b) Substantively limit development authorized in section 2.2.3 of the management plan
18	or define 'contiguous,' as used in section 2.2.3 of the management plan, so that the develop
19	ment of units can occur on up to 25 clusters that may be connected only by a road system.
20	"(4) The commission may amend the management plan only as provided in the manage
21	ment plan and only pursuant to applicable rulemaking procedures.
22	"(5) In addition to limitations on development that are contained in the managemen
23	plan, new development allowed by amendment of the management plan may not result in:
24	"(a) Negative impact on the Metolius River, its springs or its tributaries;
25	"(b) Negative impact on fish resources in the Metolius River Basin; or
26	"(c) Negative impact on the wildlife resources in the Metolius River Basin.
27	"(6) A county may not approve siting a destination resort in the Metolius River Basin.
28	"SECTION 2. This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
29	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effec

on its passage.".
