

Senate Bill 766

Sponsored by Senator HASS

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Consumer and Business Services to study options for allowing guaranteed associations to vary premiums and deductibles based on actual or expected health status of member of association or member's dependents.

Sunsets January 2, 2012.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to guaranteed associations.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Department of Consumer and Business Services shall study options for**
5 **allowing guaranteed associations to vary premiums and deductibles based on the actual or**
6 **expected health status of a member of the association or the member's dependents.**

7 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2009 Act is repealed on January 2, 2012.**
