SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Increases number of video lottery game terminals that may be placed on premises of certain race meet licensees to [40] **20**.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to video lottery game terminals on premises of race meet licensees; amending ORS 461.217.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 461.217 is amended to read:

5 461.217. (1) As used in this section, "video lottery game retailer" means a contractor under
6 contract with the Oregon State Lottery to place video lottery game terminals on premises author-
7 ized by the contract.

8 (2) A video lottery game terminal that offers a video lottery game authorized by the Director
9 of the Oregon State Lottery may be placed for operation only on the premises of an establishment
10 that has a contract with the Oregon State Lottery as a video lottery game retailer. The terminal
11 must be within the control of an employee of the video lottery game retailer. A terminal may not
12 be placed in any other business or location.

13 (3) A video lottery game terminal may be placed only on the premises of an establishment li-
14 censed by the Oregon Liquor Control Commission with a full on-premises sales license, a limited
15 on-premises sales license or a brewery-public house license. A video lottery game terminal may be
16 placed only in that part of the premises that is posted by the Oregon Liquor Control Commission
17 as being closed to minors. In addition to the requirements of this subsection, the director may by
18 rule establish such other criteria and conditions as the director determines appropriate for the
19 placement of video lottery game terminals in establishments.

20 (4) No more than six video lottery terminals may be placed in or on premises described in sub-
21 section (3) of this section.

22 (5) No more than [10] **20** video lottery game terminals may be placed on the premises of a race
23 meet licensee licensed under ORS 462.020 that qualifies as a video lottery game retailer.
