Directs Attorney General to adopt standardized charging practices for use by district attorneys in charging persons with criminal offense.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. The Attorney General shall adopt standardized charging practices for use
5	by district attorneys in charging persons with the commission of a criminal offense. The
6	standards shall:
7	(1) Encourage unbiased charging practices that are uniform across the state; and
8	(2) Have a rational relationship to the criminal justice resources available to the State
9	of Oregon.
