Requires Department of Human Services to adopt rules for face-to-face interviews with specified persons within 72 hours of receiving child abuse report.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2009 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 419B.005 to 5 419B.050.

6 SECTION 2. (1) The Department of Human Services shall adopt rules that require and

7 establish procedures for face-to-face interviews as part of the immediate investigation re-

8 quired by ORS 419B.020 (1)(a) with the following:

- 9 (a) The alleged victim;
- 10 (b) The nonoffending parent or caregiver; and

11 (c) The alleged perpetrator.

12 (2) The interviews required by subsection (1) of this section must take place within 72

- 13 hours after receipt of a report of child abuse.
