

Senate Bill 832

Sponsored by Senator GEORGE

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs semi-independent state agencies, independent not-for-profit public corporations, independent public corporations and nongovernmental entities that receive moneys from state to provide services under law or contract to provide financial information about agency, corporation or entity to Legislative Assembly upon request.

2 Relating to state finance.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** (1) Each semi-independent state agency listed in ORS 182.454, each entity
5 **denominated by statute as a semi-independent state agency, an independent not-for-profit**
6 **public corporation or an independent public corporation, and each nongovernmental entity**
7 **that receives moneys from the state to provide services described by law or under a con-**
8 **tract, shall provide to the Legislative Assembly, upon request, information about the budget**
9 **of the agency, corporation or entity, the receipts and expenditures of the agency, corporation**
10 **or entity or other financial records of the agency, corporation or entity.**

11 (2) Subsection (1) of this section applies notwithstanding the provisions of ORS 182.456
12 to 182.472, 284.300 to 284.375, 377.840, 421.352, 442.820, 576.750 to 576.775 or ORS chapter 353,
13 656 or 657 or any other provision relating to the financial status of:

14 (a) A semi-independent state agency listed in ORS 182.454;

15 (b) An entity denominated by statute as a semi-independent state agency, an independent
16 not-for-profit public corporation or an independent public corporation; or

17 (c) A nongovernmental entity that receives moneys from the state to provide services
18 described by law or under a contract.
